This spicy wine leads to have a bit more oak than most William Chris portfolio. We felt like the herbaceousness melded well with the medium toast + barrels used during aging. Mostly new oak was used in the extended aging of this wine. Look for this wine to really shine in the next 4 years. Currently this wine is rich with cherry, vanilla and coconut on the nose with pleasant cinnamon and licorish layers. On the palate this wine becomes a bit spicy leading to layers of mocha, blueberry and anise. We recommend opening this bottle and allowing the wine to breathe for 30-45 minutes before serving. This wine's limited production leads us to only release to our Hye Society family. As always all of our wines are made with minimum handling practices natural malolactic fermentation and minimum use of sulfur. Please enjoy this wine with close friends and family.
