THE WINERY

THE WINE

56% Cabernet Sauvignon

41% Merlot

3% Petit Verdot

After harvest, the wine was fermented in a combination of bins and oak fermenter. After pressing, the wine was aged for 18 months in 25% new French oak barrels.

VINEYARD(S)

This is the first year the winemakers chose to make a Cabernet Sauvignon heavy blend. Fruit from additional Hill Country vineyards was introduced adding more layers and complexity to the wine. A splash of Petit Verdot finishes the blend and adds depth of color and roundness to the wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon: Granite Hill Vineyards, Tallent Vineyards, Loyal Valley Vineyards

Merlot: Granite Hill Vineyards, Robert Clay Vineyards

Petit Verdot: Hye Estate Vineyard

TASTING NOTES

This wine is pure elegance. The nose opens with notes of acacia, clove, and vanilla which give way to rose, strawberry, ripe black cherry, raspberry, rhubarb, cigar, blackberry, and chocolate. These notes are echoed on the palate with very smooth tannins.

FOOD PAIRING

This is Bordeaux inspired blend pairs perfectly with filet mignon with wine sauce, mushroom risotto, cheddar, or cherry glazed salmon.
