2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON Fovel Family Vineyard

Now, our bottling's of this grape now span the entire state of Texas from Dell City to the Texas High Plains, to the heart of the Hill Country where the grape can get the warmth it needs.

In Gillespie County, Cassandra and Craig Fovel planted Cabernet Sauvignon in 2012. Now managed by family members Marilyn and Paul Fovel (and vineyard dog Kaizen) their couple of blocks in the heart of the Texas Hill Country is expanding. Between increasing the lengths of their underground irrigation, and diversifying their plantings, the Fovel's are hands-on with their growing.

2019 VINTAGE: A rainy May/June and warm and dry summer led into a September heat spike that shut down grapes, resulting in the latest Texas harvest in 10 years.

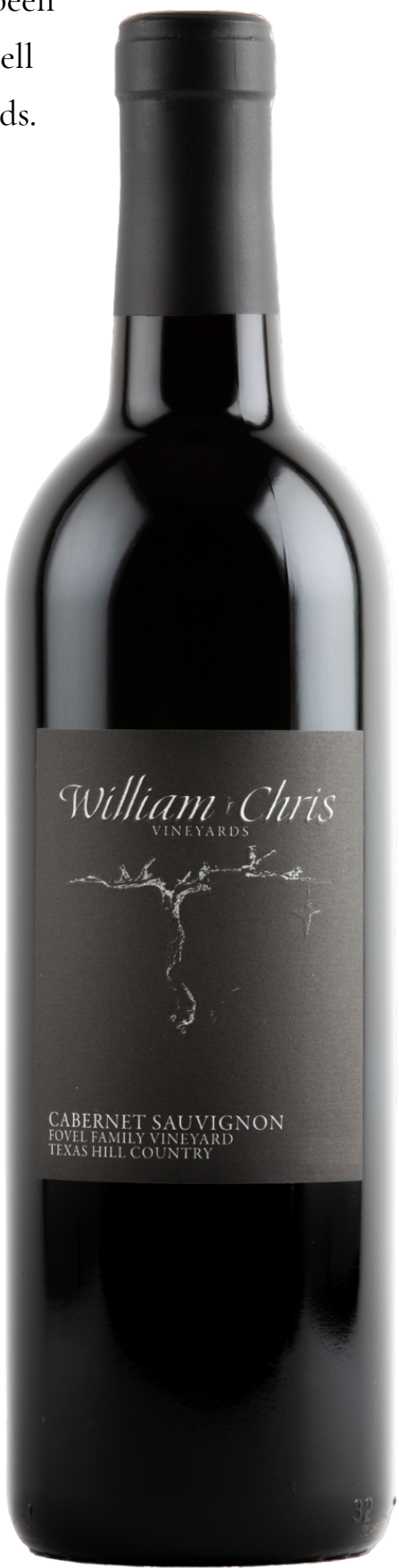
TASTING NOTES

Power meets intricacy in this full-bodied, firm wine. Unfolding in the glass the wine is spiced and warm, yet full of fresh flower and tart black berries. Layered and elegant.

Perfect pairing: A Prime cut of steak or a fine cheddar cheese.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in two lots for 12 days.

Aged for 34 months in 8% new French oak barriques.
