



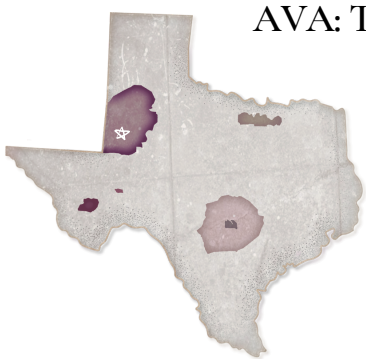

AVA: Texas High Plains

In 2010 the Seaton & Furgeson brother and sister-in-law combo planted 30 acres of grapevines to add to their collection of acres dedicated to cotton, grains, pumpkins, melons and more. Dedicated to warm climate grape varieties, the 8 generations who are currently farming this land in the Texas High Plains champion the idea of wine as a heavily farmed product of honest labor.

2019 VINTAGE: A rainy May/June and warm and dry summer led into a September heat spike that shut down grapes, resulting in the latest Texas harvest in 10 years.

TASTING NOTES

Smoldering ash and blackberry, with a savory, stony edge. A youthful and fruity palate flooded with pine, hickory, and bramble berries. Full bodied, with medium fine tannins.

FOOD PAIRING



Perfect pairing: Pork tacos and Gouda cheese. Something bold, yet earthy and nutty.



WINEMAKING: Blended from two lots harvested over a week apart. The riper fruit makes up 65% and aged apart from the younger. Each lot was aged in oak fermenters for 10 months, and barrel for 12 more.
