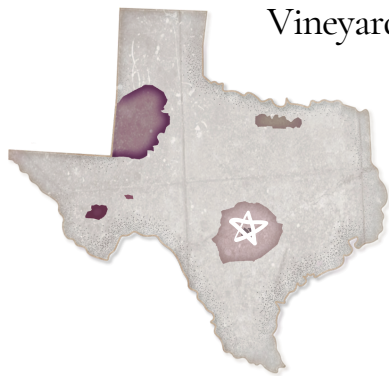
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2020 CABERNET SAUVIGNON Texas Hill Country

The Cabernet Sauvignon grape requires warm conditions in which to thrive, making the Texas Hill Country a prime spot for creating perfectly ripe Texan Cabernet Sauvignon. Warm days and not-so-cool nights provide a lengthy time for fully ripening this variety. Expect a medium-body, with jammy fruit, and a pretty edge!

VARIETIES: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot

AVA: Texas Hill Country



Vineyards: Loyal Valley Vineyard, Granite Hill Vineyard, Robert Clay Vineyard

The Texas Hill Country is the largest of the eight American Viticultural Areas of Texas, spanning 9 million acres. Incredibly diverse, the vineyards from where these grapes were sourced are perched on the Llano Uplift, a billions year old dome of granite with alluvial topsoil. This dome covers the top 2 million acres of the Texas Hill Country, including Bell Mountain AVA

2020 VINTAGE: Low yields after a 2019 freeze resulted in highly concentrated, well-balanced fruit that is packed with character.

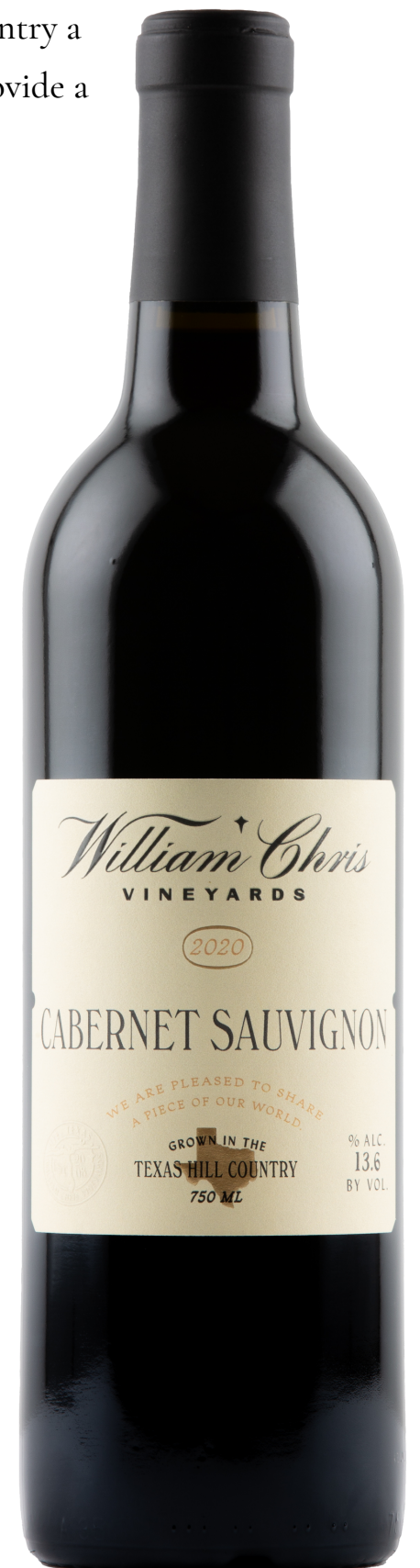
TASTING NOTES

Beautifully balanced and medium-full bodied, with chocolate and mint aromas surrounded with strawberry jam and black cherry. This wine has a stellar perfume that opens up to black tea, bergamot, and potpourri. The wine has meltaway tannins and vanilla notes from oak aging.

FOOD PAIRING



This is a rich wine for a rich dish - gamey, potato-based, cheesy dishes should be stunning with this wine!



WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak foudres for 9 days.

Aged for 29 months in 10% new French oak barriques and 90% neutral French oak barriques.

AGE OF VINES: 12 - 24 years

Serve at 59°F | Decant

SOIL TYPE: Highly varied: Decomposed granite, sandstone, hickory sand, calcareous, loam, and clay
