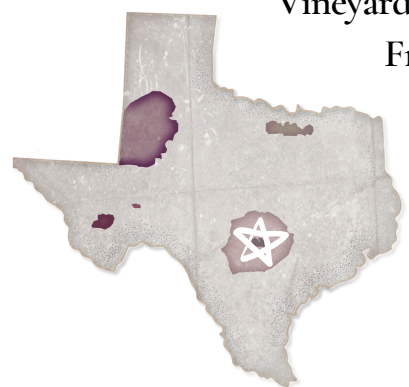


Perfect pairing: A rich dish for a rich wine - Braised lamb shank or an aged Guyère.

VARIETIES: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot, 2% Malbec

AVA: Texas Hill Country



Vineyards: Fovel Vineyard, Tallent Vineyard, Texas Hills Vineyard, Robert Clay Vineyard, Frio Canyon Vineyard, Hye Estate Vineyard, Blackmon Ranch Vineyard

With grapes sourced from across the vastness of the 9 million acres of the Texas Hill Country AVA, this wine speaks to the unique character of this singular region. Mostly sub-tropical, and expectedly hilly, this beautiful land is planted to those special grape varieties that are hardy, thick-skinned, and adaptable to a range of 'terroir'.

2020 VINTAGE: Low yields after a 2019 freeze resulted in highly concentrated, well-balanced fruit.

WINEMAKING: Fermented partially in oak fermenter and stainless steel tank. Aged separately for

14 months prior to blending, then for an additional 6 months in small French oak barriques, 35% new.

HARVEST: Machine and hand-harvested from 08/05 - 08/31

AGE OF VINES: 5-24 years

ALTITUDE: 980-2,460 ft

SOIL TYPE: Highly varied: Decomposed granite, sandstone, hickory, calcareous, limestone base

ABV: 14.4% | TA: 6.0 g/L | RS: 0.0 g/L
