THE WINERY

THE WINE

The grapes macerated for 1.5 hours on skins before direct press. Fermented in 100% Stainless Steel for 35 days, then aged 4 months stainless steel.

VINEYARD(S)

100% Texas grapes from the Vintage Press Vineyards right down the road in Stonewall, TX. Established in 2017, Doug Wilcox and Johnny Sanchez have become a great source for fresh Grenache, Tannat, Syrah, and Mourvedre. It is hard to find fresher source of grapes outside of estate plantings.

TASTING NOTES

Low-intensity salmon with Strawberry, peach candy, lime, citrus blossom, orange blossom and cocoa powder on the nose. Peach, bosc pear, and orange blossom candy on the palate.

FOOD PAIRING

Tuna Nicoise, chilled snow crab salad, white pizza, Texas chèvre (try Pure Luck or CKC Farms) Why? Peach and orange have classically been paired with cream (cream soda, anyone?) and in island dishes where you might also find fish and crab. They just work together.
