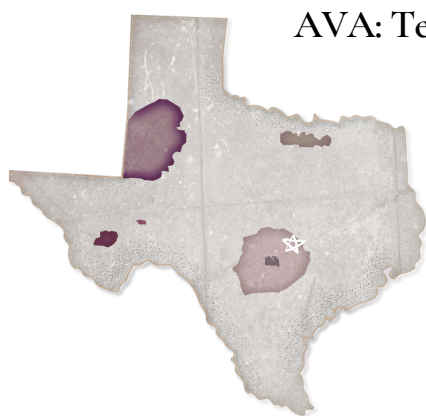
VINEYARDS

2020 MOURVÈDRE Uplift Vineyard

Mourvèdre has come to be almost synonymous with William Chris Vineyards. Highly expressive of where its grown, every Mourvèdre we make sheds more light on the full potential across all of Texas' vast terroir. Explore the rich and ancient taste of Hoover's Valley at Uplift Vineyard through the Mourvèdre grape.

AVA: Texas Hill Country

Formerly Hoover Valley Vineyard, Uplift Vineyard was renamed to represent the spirit of our industry, as well as the ancient geographical feature called the Llano Uplift that it is located on. This feature is a product of magmatic eruption and then erosion that exposed the hardened granite and mineral beneath, which appear uplifted as a result. These 55 acres of southern French and Mediterranean grape varieties were planted in the Hoover's Valley in 2013.

2020 VINTAGE: Low yields after a 2019 freeze resulted in highly concentrated, well-balanced fruit.

TASTING NOTES

Aromatic and full on the nose with Bing cherry alongside bramble berries, rose-hip and hickory smoke. Silky in texture with a medium body, perfect for flavorful dishes with medium weight like pork. A long and lingering finish that leads to notes of stone and violets.

Pair to seared bone-in pork chops with mushroom medley.
