THE WINE

Light in the glass with delicate aromas of lilac and citrus. This textured and tangy melange of nectarines, grapefruit, and strawberry meld with the satisfying spice of Cinsault.

WINEMAKING

Direct Press was used on all fruit and fermented individually and then blended after fermentation. Fermented in 100% Stainless Steel and aged for 6 months in Stainless Steel.
