THE WINERY

Founders Bill Blackmon and Chris Brundrett believe the best wines are grown (not made) and should be true to their native terroir. That's why you'll hear us say, we are pleased to share a piece of our world. We can't wait to share it with you.

THE WINE

Fermented in large 50 HL oak fermenters with 3-4 weeks bâtonnage, then aged in stainless steel for 5 months.

VINEYARD(S)

100% Texas grapes from the Dell Valley Vineyard in the Texas High Plains, just south of the New Mexico Border.

TASTING NOTES

Medium-intensity straw in color. Notes of cotton blossom, ripe lemon, green apple skin, apricot, honeysuckle, serrano, sour punch straw, and chalk. Bright acidity, sea salt, vanilla, pink grapefruit, serrano pepper.

FOOD PAIRING

Shrimp, smoked salmon and dill cream, seared swordfish with spicy chimichurri, and Grano Padano or other aged Italian. Why? Pomaceous and stone fruits can pair to a range of foods, but the round and refreshing tone of this wine calls for fresh and lightly salty hors d'oeuvres by the pool.
