



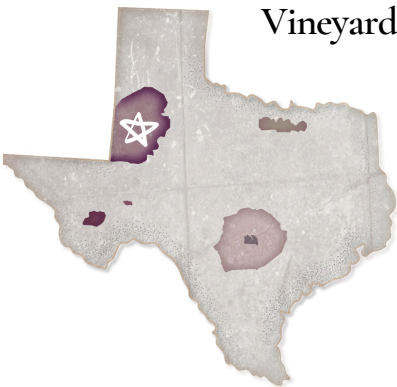

2020 SINGLE BARREL SERIES

As stated on the back label: "Each year our winemakers take time to sample our barrels as our wine continues to develop and age. From this process our team selects the best single barrel from that year's production, resulting in our Single Barrel Series. These wines are available exclusively to our very limited-capacity Single Barrel Club - a group of our most loyal fans."

VARIETIES: 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Syrah

AVA: Texas High Plains



Vineyards: Paka Family Vineyard, Hoss Fly Vineyard

The Texas High Plains is the second largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 8 million acres, yet it is responsible for the majority of the wine grapes grown in the state. A rare set of growing conditions make this area unique. On a vast flat plain, the vineyards reach elevations of 3,000 to 4,000 feet, resulting in very balanced wines.



2020 VINTAGE: Low yields after a 2019 freeze resulted in highly concentrated, well-balanced fruit that is packed with character.

TASTING NOTES

Incredible color. Fresh cherries, kirsch, black wild berries, sour raspberry, licorice jam, mocha, lingon berry, fresh cream, black cherry, sweet & sour palate, soy , savory, damp earth , blackberry syrup. M tannin, fruity, complex finish, nice hear on the back end with strawberry rollup and stone.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with decadent and smooth dark chocolate, coffee rubbed steak, kirsch-glazed boar, and other powerful bittersweet dishes.

WINEMAKING: The Cabernet Sauvignon fermented in oak fermenter for 10 days, then aged in 100% new French oak barrels for 18 months.

The Syrah fermented in oak fermenter for 21 days, then aged in 100% neutral oak barrels for 18 months.

AGE OF VINES: About 7 years

Serve at 59°F | Decant

SOIL TYPE: Fine sandy loam over some clay and limestone base

Drink now to 2038
