Our flagship wine, made every year since 2008, and always from Hill Country wine grapes. This wine was made to say “welcome, please come and share our world.” This year, the Bordeaux-style blend grew to be a bigger and bolder wine than ever before, shedding light on the future as we remember our past.

VARIETIES: 46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Malbec, 16% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot

AVA: Texas Hill Country



Vineyards: Tallent Vineyard, Loyal Valley Vineyard, Fovel Family Vineyard, Blackmon Ranch Vineyard, Uplift Vineyard

With grapes sourced from across the Texas Hill Country AVA, this wine speaks to the unique character of this region. Mostly sub-tropical, and expectedly hilly, this land is planted to grape varieties that are hardy, thick-skinned, and adaptable to a wide range of terrain and soil types.

2021 VINTAGE: A mass freeze in February and hail in May reduced quantity significantly, yet a cool summer yielded exceptional quality and balance in the remaining grapes.

WINEMAKING: All wines fermented separately for an average of 14 days. The Fovel Cabernet Sauvignon was left on skins for 30 days extended maceration. Blended and put back to barrel for 2 months before bottling.

Aged for 19 months in 26% new French oak barrels, 74% neutral French oak barrels.
