2021 MOURVÈDRE Texas High Plains



Awarded a gold medal and Top of Class in the category of Mourvèdre at the 2024-2025 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Wine Competition. Awarded a silver medal at the inaugural Vine 2 Wine International Wine Competition at the 2025 Ft. Worth Stock Show and Rodeo. Awarded a silver medal at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Wine Competition.

Gravel and black currant open up the nose with mint and thistle. This wine shows depth in brambly fruitiness with plenty of herb and dried lavender notes to keep it whimsical. The palate has just enough richness to feel decadent. Dry and medium-bodied. Medium tannins.

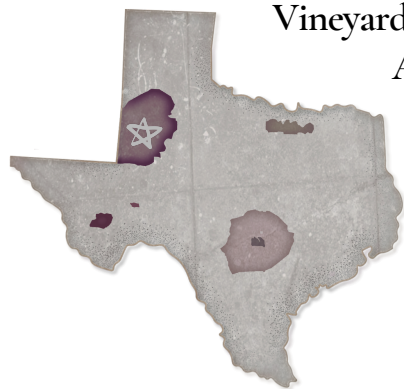


Stuffed portabella mushrooms, charred moist brisket, and steak au poivre.

The Texas High Plains is the second largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 8 million acres, yet it is responsible for the majority of the wine grapes grown in the state. A rare set of growing conditions make this area unique. On a vast flat plain, the vineyards reach elevations of 3,000 to 4,000 feet, resulting in very balanced wines.

2021 VINTAGE: A mass freeze in February and hail in May reduced quantity significantly, yet a cool summer yielded exceptional quality and balance in the remaining grapes.

WINEMAKING: All fermented separately in large oak fermenter for an average of 14 days. 20% of the blend

was aged on skins for 30 more days. Aged in 15% new French oak barrels and 85% neutral barrels for 24 months.

AGE OF VINES: 7 - 11 years

Serve at 59 °F | Decant gently

SOIL TYPE: Mostly fine sandy loam over some caliche and limestone
