



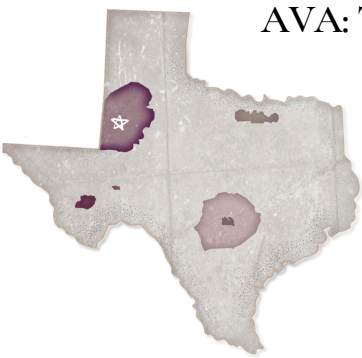
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2022 SANGIOVESE Alta Loma Vineyard

First planted in Texas in 1968, the black Sangiovese grape was selected to pair to Texas based on both its resilience in drought conditions and its proclivity for a warm temperatures. Luckily, Texas landed a grape that can grow in a range of soils, varies its profile to even slight shifts in climate, and is wonderful alongside food!

VARIETIES: 100% Sangiovese

Vineyard: Alta Loma Vineyard



AVA: Texas High Plains

Alta Loma Vineyard is a spectacular growing site in Terry County, owned and farmed by the Burran and Floyd families. Established in 2016 with fewer than 10 acres of Syrah and Sangiovese, they have since planted two more varieties that have proven sustainability in the region, including Mourvèdre. Their sandy loam soil is well-drained, suited to the hardy varieties they've selected to plant.

2022 VINTAGE: One of the driest vintages of the last few decades. About 40% reduced yield, heat that spurred ripening, and rain around harvest time led to an interesting, one-of-a-kind vintage.

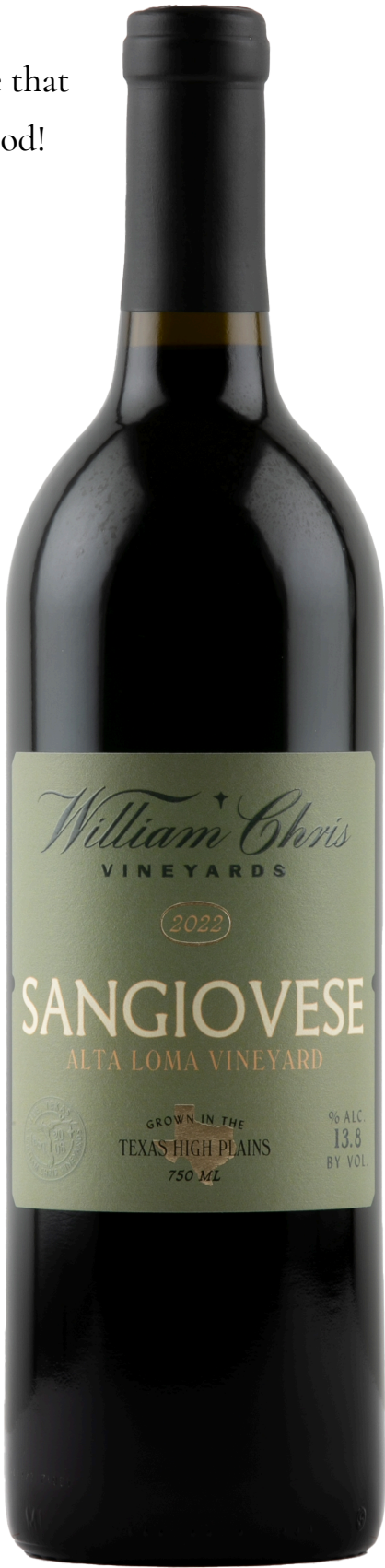
TASTING NOTES

Sour raspberry, wild strawberry, and rhubarb aromas under folds of chocolate shavings, pistachio shell, and black pepper as the wine opens up. Decant to explore the wine more nuances in this wine. Medium-bodied, complimenting tannins, and good acidity to balance a generous texture.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with duck with port-cherry glaze, braised oxtail, and sun-dried tomato fettuccini Alfredo.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank for 14 days.

Aged in 15% new French oak barrels and 85% neutral barrels for 17 months.

AGE OF VINES: 6 years

Serve at 59°F | Decant

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam
