



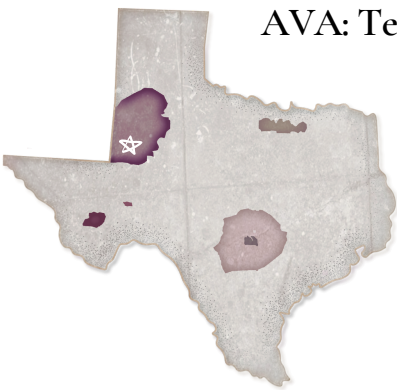
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2022 SANGIOVESE Phillips Vineyard

First planted in Texas in 1968, the black Sangiovese grape was selected to pair to Texas based on both its resilience in drought conditions and its proclivity for a warm temperatures. Luckily, Texas landed a grape that can grow in a range of soils, varies its profile to even slight shifts in climate, and is wonderful alongside food!

VARIETIES: 100% Sangiovese

AVA: Texas High Plains

This 20-acre plot in Terry County was planted in 2015 by Tony and Madonna Phillips, who were 3rd generation cotton farmers before expanding to wine grapes. The Phillips' growing philosophy includes touching every grape to learn from thriving vines on their carefully selected spot on top of the hill. We've worked with both their Sangiovese and Touriga Nacional varieties.

2022 VINTAGE: One of the driest vintages of the last few decades. About 40% reduced yield, heat that spurred ripening, and rain around harvest time led to an interesting, one-of-a-kind vintage.

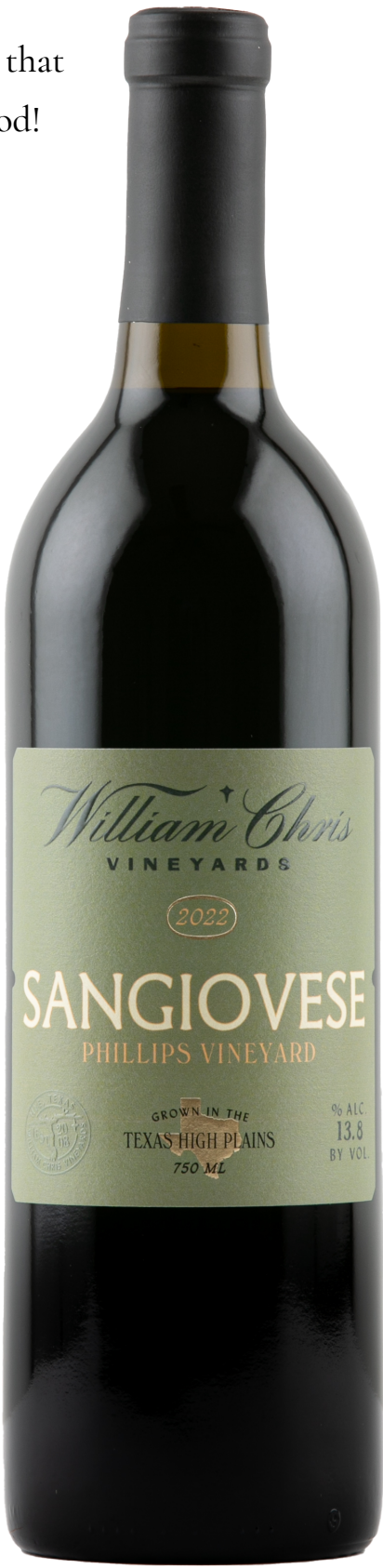
TASTING NOTES

Aromatic and harmonious, with soft red fruit, rose, walnut oil, hickory, and a touch of maple. Earthy notes will develop nicely over time in bottle. The palate has great tannin levels, a medium body, a candied nature to the fruit, and the perfect amount of well-integrated acidity.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with spaghetti bolognese, gamier fair such as goat, and semi firm to firm cheeses like Emmental.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak fermenter for 16 days.

Aged in 15% new Eastern European oak barrels and 85% neutral barrels for 17 months.

AGE OF VINES: 2 years

Serve at 59°F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over caliche
