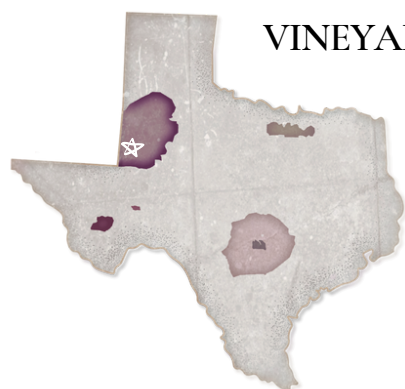
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2023 ACROSS OLD LAMESA

Across from each other on Old Lamesa Road in Terry County are vineyards that are owned and operated by friends and family. This blend represents those people and how those vineyards influence each other's products.

VARIETIES: 60% Mourvèdre, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon

AVA: Texas High Plains



VINEYARDS: La Pradera Vineyard, Alta Loma Vineyard COUNTY: Terry

The Texas High Plains is the second largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 8 million acres, yet it is responsible for the majority of the wine grapes grown in the state. A rare set of growing conditions make this area unique. On a vast flat plain, the vineyards reach elevations of 3,000 to 4,000 feet, resulting in very balanced wines.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with balance.

TASTING NOTES

Dry and medium-bodied with red fruit, fresh flowers, crushed stone, and zesty herbs. The palate is rounded by moderate structure, and base tones of earth and blackberry.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with chicken dishes, tomato sauce, semi-soft to semi-firm cheeses, and turkey.



WINEMAKING: Each variety was fermented separately for an average of 12 days.

Aged in 100% neutral oak barrels for 20 months.

AGE OF VINES: 7-13 years

Serve at 59° F | Decant

SOIL TYPE: Brown clay-ey loam and reddish find sandy laom with some limestone

Drink now to 2032
