Enchanté is a Bordeaux-style blend and our first flagship wine made since 2008 when we opened. It is crafted yearly and named Enchanté to say "welcome, please come share my world."

VARIETIES: 71% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Malbec, 9% Merlot

VINEYARD: Uplift Vineyard, Fovel Family Vineyard

COUNTY: Burnet, Gillespie

The Texas Hill Country is the largest of the eight American Viticultural Areas of Texas, spanning 9 million acres. With diverse soil types and bedrock, including both limestone and granite, and varying elevations, the potential for this region is magnificent as long as the varieties planted are resilient against the Hill Country's signature warmth and humidity.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with balance.

WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak fermenter for 10 days.

Aged in 20% new French oak barrels and 80% neutral oak barrels for 20 months.

AGE OF VINES: 6 - 11 years

Serve at 59° F | Decant up to 30 minutes

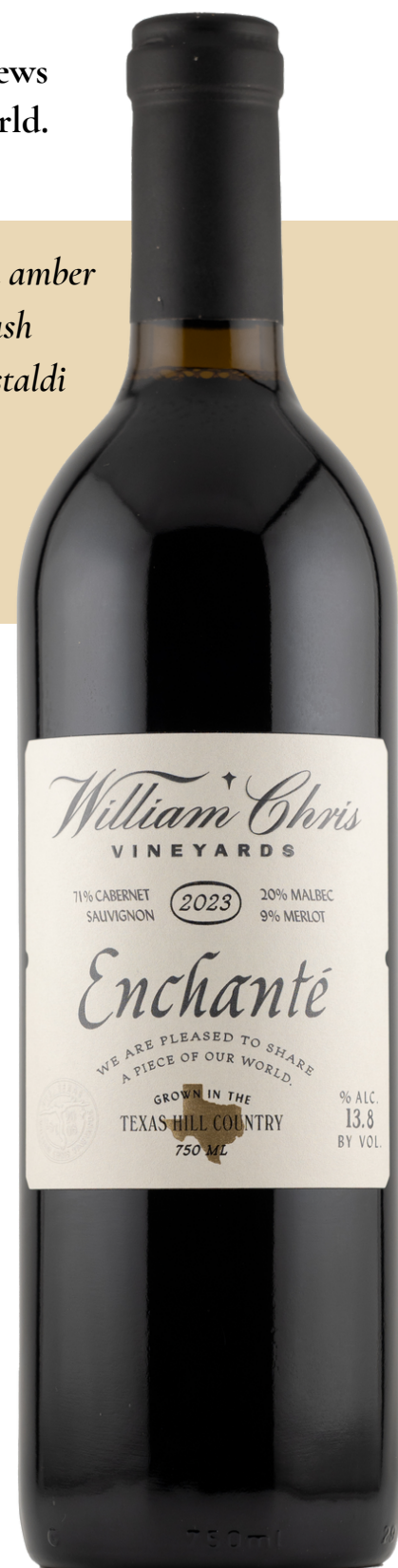
