



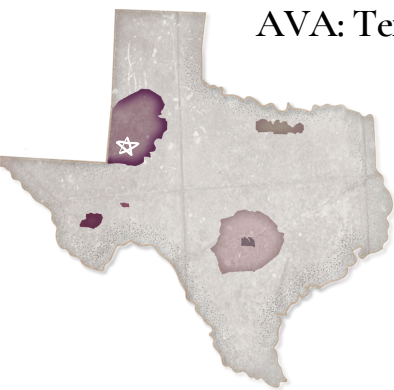

2023 MOURVÈDRE ROSÉ La Pradera Vineyard

Mourvèdre, a smokey and edgy red grape that loves plenty of sun and warmth, is one of our choice grapes to make rosé! Not just any fruity pink wine, Mourvèdre brings texture and complexity with each sip - a beautiful representation of a single grape variety from a single vineyard in the Texas High Plains AVA.

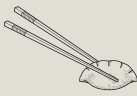
Established in 2010 by Mike and Barbara Paddock with the help of Texas grape-growers Andy and Lauren Timmons, who also currently manage the 120 acres. The different grape varieties are planted on a special soil combination that is calcareous, organic, sandyloam over limestone that is just 2-3 feet deep in some blocks. The wines are aromatic and fresh in style.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

TASTING NOTES

The aroma is rich and full, with notes of freesia, ripe strawberry, cherry soda pop syrup, rhubarb, banana chips, and the scent of a cool breeze from spearmint leaf. The palate is bright and light-bodied, with a lingering ripe fruitiness and a thirst-quenching factor.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with a dish with an acid component such as a tuna Niçoise with a dijon vinaigrette.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank. Picked early for acidity.

Bottled after 6 months in stainless steel tank.

Serve at 49°F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base
