In October 2025, Cristaldi & Co. rated this Petit Verdot 94 points out of 100.

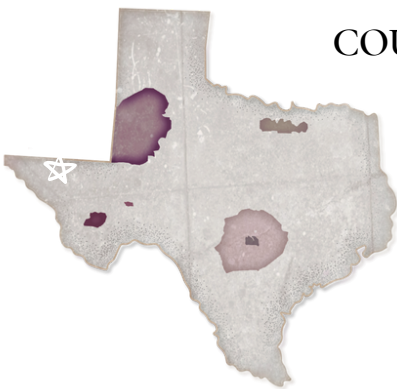

Pair with heavy game such as bison or lamb, hearty beef dishes or earthy dishes such as with farro.

VARIETIES: 100% Petit Verdot

VINEYARD: Dell Valley Vineyard



COUNTY: Hudspeth

Continuously planted since 1987, the vines at Dell Valley are deeply rooted in sloped sandy, caliche soils at over 3,500 ft elevation. Sitting next to vast alfalfa fields outside of any currently designated American Viticultural Area, the vines are mightily tended by Philippe, whose experience with growing grapevines began at an early age on the French island of Corsica.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with balance.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak fermenter for 15 days.

Aged in 50% new French oak barrels and 50% neutral oak barrels for 16 months.

AGE OF VINES: 13 years

Serve at 59° F | Decant

SOIL TYPE: Sandy loam over caliche with river rock

Drink now to 2034

ELEVATION: 3,750 feet
