



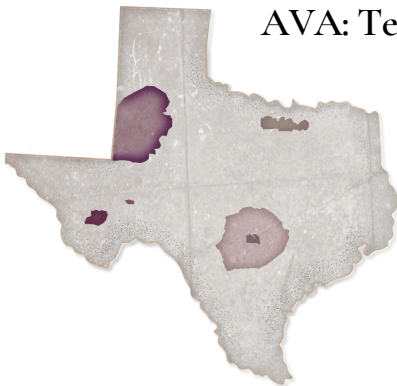

2023 ROSÉ La Pradera Vineyard

La Pradera Vineyard has been a proud partner of William Chris Vineyards every single year since 2012. This rosé and its bold label were made entirely in celebration of those partners of ours who are responsibly farming the exemplary vineyard sites of Texas. This wine embraces the brambly, spiced aromas of the heat-tolerant variety Cinsault.

VARIETIES: 83% Cinsault, 17% Mourvèdre

COUNTY: Terry

Established in 2010 by Mike and Barbara Paddock with the help of Texas grape-growers Andy and Lauren Timmons, who also currently manage the 120 acres. The different grape varieties are planted on a special soil combination that is calcareous, organic, sandyloam over limestone that is just 2-3 feet deep in some blocks. The wines are aromatic and fresh in style.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

TASTING NOTES

A wild rosé with aromas of red currant and bramble notes accompanied by stone and lilies. There is an element of black cherry pit that is surprising. The palate is as wild as the nose, with a spritz-y effervescence and a textured dryness.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with gamey meats or roasted root vegetables. Also, charcuterie with cheeses and pickled veggies!



WINEMAKING: Stainless steel tank fermented for 21 days.

Aged in concrete egg for 4 months.

AGE OF VINES: 13 years

Serve at 49°F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base

Drink now to 2027
