Vineyards: Friesen Family Vineyard, La Pradera Vineyard

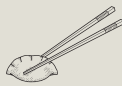
The Texas High Plains AVA is the second largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 8 million acres, and responsible for the majority of the wine grapes grown in the state. This is where co-founder William "Bill" Blackmon planted his first vineyards in 1984. A rare set of growing conditions make this area unique, including 3,000-4,000 feet elevation on a flat, high sandy plain.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

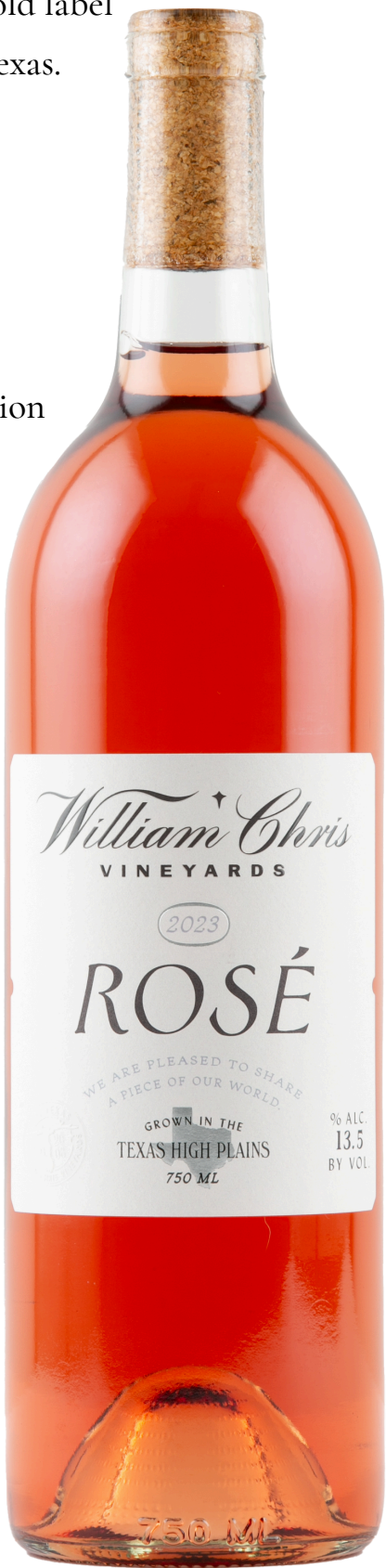
TASTING NOTES

Deeply pink in color. Delicious aromas of guava, peach, red apple and river rock! The palate has a ripe peach juiciness, with lingering strawberry notes that last past fresh acidity and the dry finish. A slight rich warmth comes on the finish. Medium body.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with thick flake fish, including bass, halibut, and even freshwater salmon. Or, a strawberry salad.



WINEMAKING: All varieties were fermented separately for an average of 25 days. The wines were then blended after primary fermentation. Aged for 5 months in stainless steel tank. No malolactic fermentation.

AGE OF VINES: 10 - 13 years

Serve at 49°F

SOIL TYPE: Sandy and caliche soils with some limestone base

Drink now to 2028
