



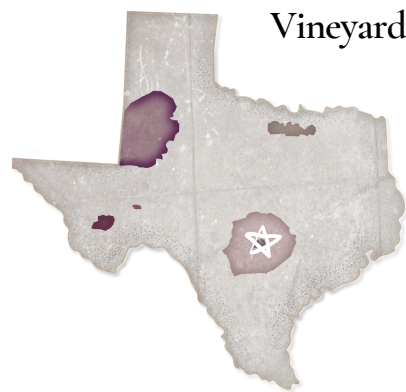
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2023 ROSÉ Texas Hill Country

This wine is a representation of the first grapes picked in the Texas Hill Country, when sugar levels are low and the bright acidity shines through. This wine is made from only the delicate free run juice of red grape varieties. The flavors highlight the low mountainous terrain of the Texas Hill Country with all its complexity and mineral focus.

VARIETIES: 72% Mourvèdre, 28% Grenache

The Texas Hill Country is the largest of the eight American Viticultural Areas of Texas, spanning 9 million acres. With diverse soil types and bedrock, including both limestone and granite, and varying elevations, the potential for this region is magnificent as long as the varieties planted are resilient against the Hill Country's signature warmth and humidity.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is ripe and refreshing, with notes of nectarine and ripe red plum, and with tropical notes of melon, salted pineapple, and candied strawberry. The palate is a smooth medium body with a salty acidity and lean, dry fruitiness.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with salty snacks that will pop out the fruit - baked potato chips, popcorn, or popcorn shrimp.



WINEMAKING: Picked early for freshness and acidity. Fermented in stainless steel tank for 34 days.

Bottled after 6 months aging in stainless steel.

AGE OF VINES: 8 - 10 years

Serve at 49°F

SOIL TYPE: Decomposed granite and sandy loam, and clay loam over limestone

Drink now to 2027
