



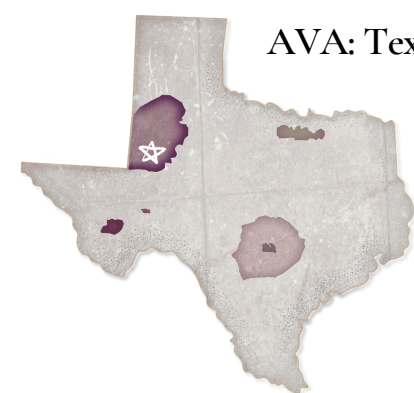
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2023 SANGIOVESE Phillips Vineyard

First planted in Texas in 1968, Sangiovese is resilient in drought conditions and warm temperatures. It can grow in a range of soils, varies its profile to even slight shifts in climate, and is wonderful alongside food.

VARIETY: 100% Sangiovese

COUNTY: Terry

This 20-acre plot was planted in 2015 by Tony and Madonna Phillips. They were 3rd generation cotton farmers before expanding to wine grapes such as Sangiovese and Touriga Nacional varieties. The Phillips' growing philosophy includes touching every grape to learn from thriving vines on their carefully selected spot on top of the hill.

2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at ideal pH and acidity levels with balance.

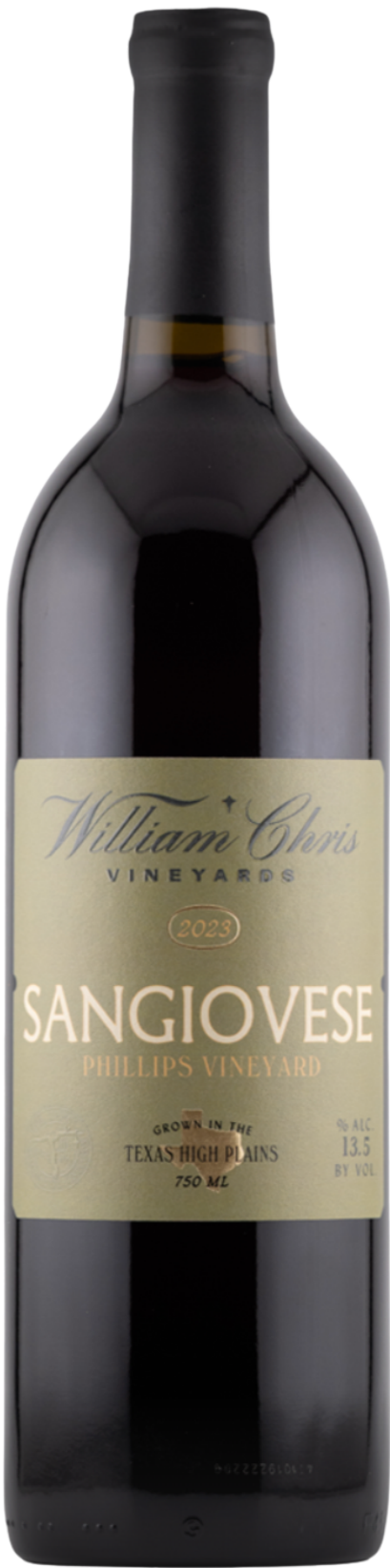
TASTING NOTES

Soft, dry, and bright, balanced by a fountain of gentle ripe red fruit and a silky texture. Defined by intricacies of dried herbs, a brush of warm spices, and the classic High Plains orange peel aroma. The wine gives Old Fashioned vibes with all the subtleties of wine!

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with pork belly, pumpkin fritters, and seafood or vegetable tempura.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak fermenter.

Aged in 15% new Eastern European oak barrels and 85% neutral oak barrels for 16 months.

AGE OF VINES: 8 years

Serve at 59° F | Decant gently

SOIL TYPE: Deep Amarillo fine sandy loam over caliche

Drink now to 2031
