



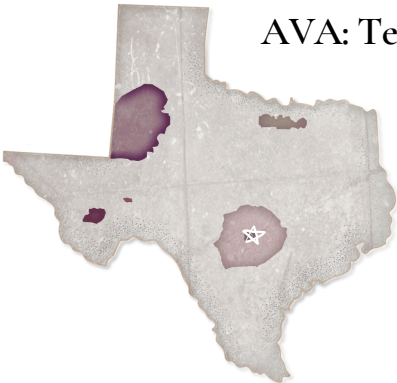

Every year our winemaker’s craft special blends from their favorite grapes that were grown that year. These wines are not only an imprint of a single vintage but of a singular person who has been a part of our story over time.

VARIETIES: 75% Tannat, 25% Grenache

AVA: Texas Hill Country



In 2016 Doug Wilcox planted 12 acres of the four grape varieties used in the Artist Blend, just a stones' throw from Hye, in Stonewall, Texas. The Texas Hill Country is the largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 9 million acres, and is home to some of the oldest soils and subsoils in the United States.



2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at the ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

TASTING NOTES

Striking in color and deep on the nose, with crushed stone, boysenberry, and kindled coffee bean. The aroma is cool rather than rich or thick - nicely mysterious. It explodes on the palate with a structure that begs for decanting or bottle age. Highly mineral, focused acidity, and firm tannins structure, laced by tart blackberries on the finish.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with game meat, especially elk medallions with a red wine jus and an herb component.
