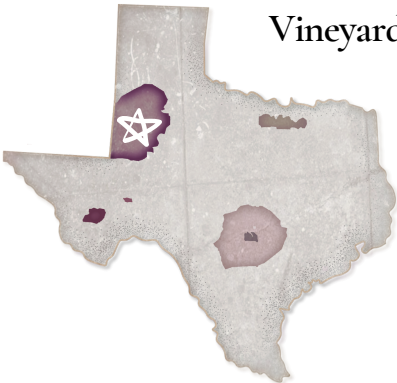
2023 WINEMAKER’S SERIES “TC’s Root”

On the back label: “We have a tradition at our dinner table to share our rose, thorn and seed of the day. The Rose - the best thing that happened, the Thorn - the worst thing that happened and the Seed - what you can learn from. This wine is dedicated to my daughter Tess, who added The Root to the custom - what made you laugh today. When you open this wine, reflect on your rose, thorn, seed, and root. “

WINEMAKER: Chris Brundrett

VARIETIES: 75% Sangiovese, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Mourvèdre

AVA: Texas High Plains



Vineyards: La Pradera Vineyard, Alta Loma Vineyard

The Texas High Plains is the second largest designated grape-growing region in Texas, spanning 8 million acres, yet it is responsible for the majority of the wine grapes grown in the state. A rare set of growing conditions make this area unique. On a vast flat plain, the vineyards reach elevations of 3,000 to 4,000 feet, resulting in very balanced wines.



2023 VINTAGE: Much needed rain and mild temperatures before several weeks of long 100+ degree temperatures. Sugars stalled, but grapes were harvested at the ideal pH and acidity levels with great balance.

TASTING NOTES

Rosebushes and red berries push out of the glass with an intriguing savory spice and the juicy hint of bubblegum. The palate immediately satisfies the intrigue on the nose, coating the mouth with lush fruit and texture, but lifting off to reveal a wide array of wilting garden herbs and wild raspberry notes. Silty tannins on a medium body. Dry.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with delicate beef carpaccio, earthy mushrooms, and a nutty washed-rind cheese.

WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank and large oak fermenter.	Serve at 59°F Decant
Aged in separate lots for 10 months, then blended just prior bottling.	Drink now to 2031
