In October 2025, Cristaldi & Co. rated this Chenin Blanc 92 points out of 100.

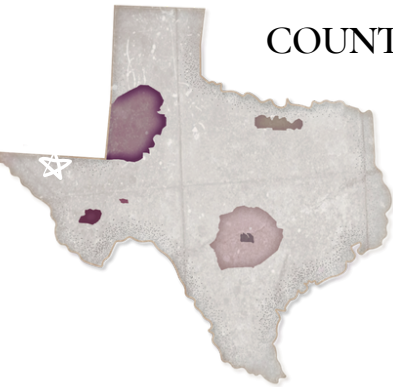

Pair with fresh seafood, especially sushi or sashimi, and crisp romaine salads with strong cheeses to top.

VARIETIES: 100% Chenin Blanc

VINEYARD: Dell Valley Vineyard



COUNTY: Hudspeth

Originally planted in 1987, the vines at Dell Valley Vineyard are thick and deeply rooted in the sloped sandy, caliche type soils of West Texas. Sitting outside of any currently designated American Viticultural Area, or AVA, this vineyard is mightily tended by Phillipe, whose experience with growing grapevines began at an early age on the French island of Corsica.

2024 VINTAGE: Elevated moisture levels posed challenges in late summer, but proactive vineyard management mitigated these issues. Overall, the vintage was one of the best in a decade.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank and oak barriques for an average of 24 days.

Partial malolactic conversion to retain acidity. Aged in large oak fermenter for 7 months.

AGE OF VINES: Over 12 years

Serve at 49° F

SOIL TYPE: Sandy loam over caliche with river rock
