



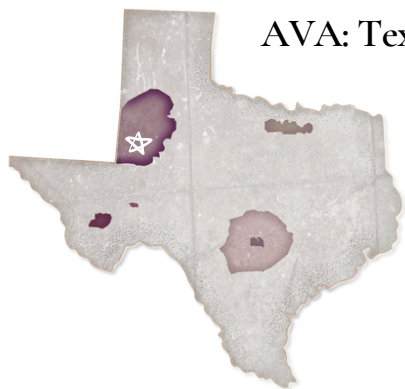

2024 CINSAULT Lost Draw Vineyard

This red grape finds itself in warm regions that embrace the brambly, spiced aromas of this heat tolerant variety. This grape is a no-brainer for the intense conditions in Texas and makes a wonderful pairing to Latin cuisine!

AVA: Texas High Plains

County: Terry

Tended to by the modern pioneers of the Texas vineyard management, Andy and Lauren Timmons planted Lost Draw Vineyard way back in 2005. Their 75 acres are devoted to grapes that can be grown sustainably in the semi-arid Texas High Plains AVA, as are the other vineyard sites they manage. Sustainability means farming that focuses on the future grapevine health.

2024 VINTAGE: A mild winter transitioned into steady rainfall into late spring, ensuring proper bud break and fruit set. A cooler summer enabled ripeness without risking metabolic stalling.

TASTING NOTES

Beautifully ripe, with stewed strawberry, red plum, and sundried tomato, and laced with aromas of cinnamon stick, cedar, and Maplewood. This is such a food-friendly wine, with just enough kick to be interesting solo, but a moderate balance that leaves room for flavorful food!

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with earthy-savory dishes, even with some spice - tamales, tacos al pastor, and Thai noodles.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in a combination of stainless steel tank and large oak fermenter.

Aged in 10% new French oak barrels and 90% neutral barrels for 15 months.

AGE OF VINES: 19 years

Serve at 59° F | Decant
