2024 MOURVÈDRE ROSÉ Moonlight Vineyard

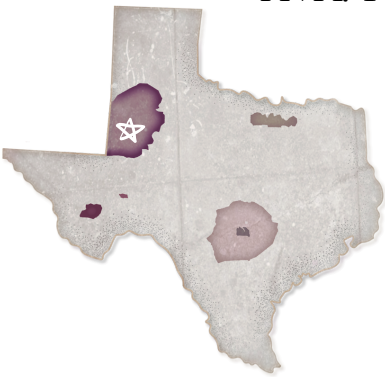
Mourvèdre, a smokey and edgy red grape that loves plenty of sun and warmth, is one of our choice grapes to make rosé! Not just any fruity pink wine, Mourvèdre brings texture and complexity with each sip - a beautiful representation of a single grape variety from the Texas High Plains AVA.

Moonlight Vineyard is less than 10 acres of grapes established in Brownfield by George and Peggy Seely (2014). Miss Peggy worked with Andy Timmons (a well established grower in the Texas High Plains) for years before getting the wild hair to plant their own couple of red and white varieties. To our delight, the crop has been incredible since year one and is one of the few Texas vineyards to be recognized as sustainable by the BioTech Research Institute.

2024 VINTAGE: A mild winter transitioned into steady rainfall into late spring, ensuring proper bud break and fruit set. A cooler summer enabled ripeness without risking metabolic stalling.

TASTING NOTES

A rosé that balances jolly rancher strawberry with grounding minerality that keeps the candied nature nicely restrained. Opulent red fruit, a squeeze of a lemon rind, and melon mingle on the palate, burst through with laser beam acidity that folds into a medium body and herb finish.

Pair with flavorful dishes - pasta salad, corn salsa, and a hearty tuna Niçoise salad.
