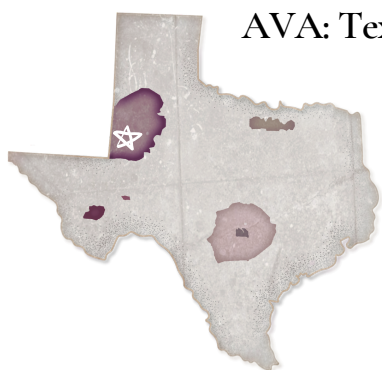
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2024 PÉTILLANT NATUREL SPARKLING ROSÉ

Fondly shortened to 'Pét Nat', this style of wine stands for 'naturally a little sparkling'. Because the wine finishes its winemaking process while the bottle is sealed, the wine is fizzy, unfiltered, and highly textured. Chill well before opening.

VARIETIES: 52% Mourvèdre, 48% Carignan

VINEYARD: La Pradera Vineyard



AVA: Texas High Plains

COUNTY: Terry

Established in 2010 by Mike and Barbara Paddock with the help of Texas grape-growers Andy and Lauren Timmons, who also currently manage the 120 acres. The 13 different grape varieties are planted on a special soil combination that is calcareous, organic, sandy loam over limestone that is just 2-3 feet deep in some blocks. The wines are aromatic and fresh in style.

2024 VINTAGE: A mild winter transitioned into steady rainfall into late spring, ensuring proper bud break and fruit set. A cooler summer enabled ripeness without risking metabolic stalling.

TASTING NOTES

Citrusy, with an overall tropical-passion fruit and red berries aroma medley. Mandarin orange mingles with a lime-y mineral note. The palate feels chalky and nicely dry but still gushing with a mouth-watering citrus-red-apple-raspberry-punch flavor. Light-bodied, but with texture.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with meatballs and other Italian dishes, soft and fresh cheeses, and anything spicy.



WINEMAKING: Picked early to retain acidity. The varieties were co-fermented in stainless steel tank for 29 days at a cool 53° F. Bottled at the end of fermentation to capture natural carbonation. Undisgorged.

AGE OF VINES: 14 years

Serve at 45° F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base
