In October 2025, James Suckling rated this Sauvignon Blanc 92 points out of 100.

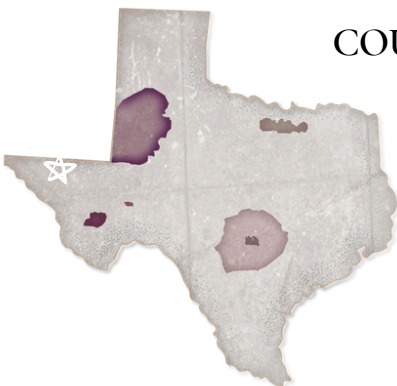

VARIETIES: 91% Sauvignon Blanc, 9% Semillon

VINEYARD: Dell Valley Vineyard



COUNTY: Hudspeth

Continuously planted since 1987, the vines at Dell Valley are deeply rooted in sloped sandy, caliche soils at over 3,500 ft elevation. Sitting next to vast alfalfa fields outside of any currently designated American Viticultural Area, the vines are mightily tended by Philippe, whose experience with growing grapevines began at an early age on the French island of Corsica.

2024 VINTAGE: Elevated moisture levels posed challenges in late summer, but proactive vineyard management mitigated these issues. Overall, the vintage was one of the best in a decade.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in large oak fermenter, large concrete fermenter, and oak barriques for an average of 28 days. Aged in large oak fermenter and large concrete vessel for 7 months.

AGE OF VINES: 36 years
