



Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2024 SPARKLING SAUVIGNON BLANC Pétillant Naturel

Fondly shortened to 'Pét Nat', this style of wine stands for 'naturally a little sparkling'. Because the wine finishes its winemaking process while the bottle is sealed, the wine is fizzy, unfiltered, and highly textured. Chill well before opening.

VARIETY: 100% Sauvignon Blanc
METHOD: Ancestral

VINEYARD: Boxing Rabbit Vineyard



AVA: Texas High Plains COUNTY: Hockley

Originally Martin Vineyard, Boxing Rabbit Vineyard was planted in 1975 by Andy Martin and identifies itself as the oldest continuously running commercial vineyard in Texas. Today, there are over 30 acres planted to 11 grape varieties. Current owners Preston and Kelly Alison are reviving these old vines to ensure they can express their maturity through wine!

2024 VINTAGE: A mild winter transitioned into steady rainfall into late spring, ensuring proper bud break and fruit set. A cooler summer enabled ripeness without risking metabolic stalling.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of tropical fruit, florals, grass, citrus, and toasty characters add depth from the partial bottle fermentation process. Flavors of brioche, serious minerality, and hints of herb play through apple notes on the palate. Just under medium-bodied, and fully dry. For the "foodie."

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with intense seafood and refreshing chicken dishes, especially with citrus, herb, and vegetables.



WINEMAKING: Hand-picked early in the season to preserve natural acidity. Whole cluster pressed.

Bottled at the end of fermentation to capture natural carbonation. Undisgorged.
