



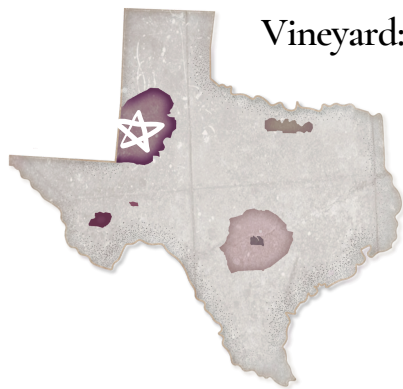
Focused on Texas grown wines made in an Old World style with low-intervention winemaking. Since 2008, founders William "Bill" Blackmon and Chris Brundrett have sourced grapes from Estate vineyards and partners alike, prizing sustainable practices and the expression of Texan terroir.

2025 ROSÉ Texas High Plains

A representation of the first grapes picked in the Texas High Plains, when sugar levels are low and the bright acidity shines through. This wine is made from only the delicate free run juice of red grape varieties.

VARIETIES: 100% Mourvèdre

Vineyard: La Pradera Vineyard COUNTY: Terry

Established in 2010 by Mike and Barbara Paddock with the help of Texas grape-growers Andy and Lauren Timmons, who also currently manage the 120 acres. The different grape varieties are planted on a special soil combination that is calcareous, organic, sandyloam over limestone that is just 2-3 feet deep in some blocks. The wines are aromatic and fresh in style.

2025 VINTAGE: Solid spring and summer rains gave the vines a healthy start to the season. Moderate temperatures and a dry harvest led to a long season and exceptional grape development.

TASTING NOTES

Dichotomous aromas of jolly rancher and crushed stone - both serious and thirst-quenching at the same time. The wine smells of watermelons and strawberries, a sprig of mint, and the sea. The palate is deliciously dry, with a subtly chalky texture, and calm, candied fruit finish.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with crawfish, spicy Thai food, and pork meatballs where it will cut through the richness.



WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank at a cool 55° F for 20 days.

Aged in stainless steel tank for a quick 6 months before bottling.

AGE OF VINES: 15 years

Serve at 45-49° F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base
