



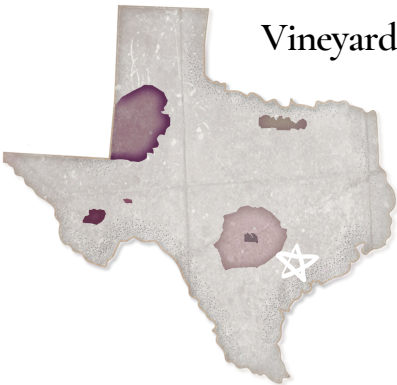

NV BLANC DU BOIS PÉT NAT Sparkling Wine

While it may sound French in origin, Blanc du Blois is an American hybrid grape invented in Florida by crossing several grapevine species in order to yield a brand new, floral and citrus driven white grape variety. As a result, Texas now grows this grape that can survive in the hot and humid regions of Texas where other grapes cannot.

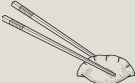
Vineyards: Fleming Farms Vineyard, Darst Ranch Vineyard, John Dale Vineyard

Situated outside of any currently defined AVA is the Texas Gulf Coastal region where many acres of hybrid and native grapevines thrive. In this region of Texas, Blanc du Bois is king due to its resilience in humid conditions, which is a trait from its southern-U.S. heritage. Each of these vineyards are a just a couple of acres dedicated mostly to this single grape.

TASTING NOTES

Vibrant with lime zest on the nose, white peach, and a zesty-ness that won't quit! Classic notes of lemongrass, nectarine, lime, and stone roll together onto a delightfully bubbly palate. The bubbles are aggressive and will hold the wine until sophisticated nutty notes emerge. Light-bodied.

FOOD PAIRING



This wine will do best with a dish that has a tropical, herbaceous, or seafood focus, such as shish kabobs.



WINEMAKING: All fermented in separate lots in stainless steel tanks for 12 - 38 days. Aged in separate lots in neutral oak barrels for 2 - 18 months before blending into a neutral barrel for 3 more months.

BOTTLING DATE: 12/24/2023

Serve at 45°F

SOIL TYPE: Varied, with clay and some sand

Drink now to 2028
